Studying the interior design materials used directly by man through modern techniques – innovative aesthetic values.

1107 04 Wall Cladding Technology

Studying modern techniques of the cladding different methods – wall surface treatment in the field of interior design – function – used materials.

2108 04 Floor and Ceiling Technology

Modern techniques of the different floor and ceiling treatment methods in interior design – function – appropriate materials.

3109 04 Furniture Materials Technology (1)

Studying modern techniques of natural and artificial wood used in furniture manufacturing – metal accessories.

4109 04 Furniture and Interior Design Components Technology

Innovative techniques for the interior design elements.

1111 04 Geometric Perspective

Geometric shapes and its transformation into tridimensional solid – studying different types of perspective.

2112 04 computer (Major)

Using computers in interpreting interior design and furniture data into the form of sectors, projections, working drawings and geometric perspective.

1112 04 Interior Design and Furniture History (Ancient Egypt) (1)

Accurate description and technical analysis of artistic characteristics related to the interior design development stages (Predynastic – Old kingdom – Middle kingdom – New kingdom).

2112 04 Interior Design and Furniture History (Islamic) (2)

Accurate description and technical analysis of the distinctive artistic characteristics that produced the civilization in Umayyad, Fatimid, Ayyubid, Mamluk and Ottoman periods.

3112 04 Interior Design and Furniture History (Modern) (4)

Accurate description and technical analysis of the distinctive artistic characteristics that produced Pre-Renaissance and Renaissance in England and France.

2113 04 Theories of Interior Design (1)

Descriptive theory - simple theory - organic theory.

3114 04 Specifications, Contracts and Costs

The technical methods of scheduling materials cost – the final cost calculation within the limits of the small-scale and large-scale projects economics.

1115 04 Executive Specialization (1)

Simple working drawings in the light of the technical terminology of some maquettes selected from the design projects and executing them.

2115 04 Executive Specialization (2)
